<p>The subject is closely related to the Architecture and Landscape Architecture Spatial Theory and Open Space Planning and Design. The course introduces students to real-world challenges of concepts and technical details through the construction of mixed-material models.</p>

TETTD177N	URBANISM	3 ECTS
<p>The subject deals with contemporary issues in urbanism, with a special focus on the joint professional collaboration between landscape and urban planners. Within the framework of urbanism, it will focus on possible methods for the regeneration of neighbourhoods undergoing historic transformation. The lectures will present and analyse the context of planning theory and experiences from contemporary national and international planning practice.</p>		

TETTD183N	URBAN ECOLOGY	2 ECTS
<p>The aim of the course is to introduce the theoretical foundations of Urban Ecology and to integrate them through a practical exercise. The lectures will give an overview of the basic knowledge. The practical course of the subject will provide support for applications in urban planning and landscape architecture through a problem-solving project assignment. The project assignment is "Climate Adaptive Housing and Public Space"</p>

TETTD126N	LANDSCAPE GRAPHICS AND VISUAL COMMUNICATION 2	4 ECTS
<p>Design of small garden architectures at the idea level, using different structural approaches. Landscape elements carry organic motifs, while geometric abstraction is also present. The designs are illustrated by models using different materials.</p>		

TETTD161N	PLANT USE IN SPATIAL COMPOSITIONS 2	2 ECTS
<p>The use of the ornamental plants learned earlier is reinforced in class and in assignments. The different types of ecological conditions allow the design of different plant groups, which are presented in the thematic small tasks. The planting plans will lay the groundwork for the end-of-semester and larger scale assignments for the next semester.</p>		

TETTD175N	RESTORATION OF HISTORICAL GARDENS, LANDSCAPES	6 ECTS
<p>The course introduces students to the theory and practice of restoration of historic gardens and landscapes. In addition to the use of general design skills, students will learn the practical basics of restoration and the specificities of heritage conservation, both in terms of design regulations and the theoretical background to design. Through theoretical presentations and case studies by various speakers, students will learn about national and international practices in the field of heritage conservation and restoration. The most important aim of the course is to convey an approach that strikes the right balance between historical authenticity and creative imagination.</p>		

TETTD070N	CONTEMPORARY ART	4 ECTS
<p>In the Contemporary Art course, students learn about contemporary art problems through lectures and visits to museums and galleries. It is important that they learn about the subject through the analysis of current modern and contemporary art exhibitions and not only from secondary sources..</p>		

TETTD229N	LANDSCAPE PLANNING IN BUDAPEST AGGLOMERATION	4 ECTS
<p>The course gives an overview of the most typical landuse conflicts, nature values in Budapest Agglomeration area.          Topics: landuse conflicts and developments in Budapest Agglomeration area</p>		

TETTD222N	SPECIAL DENDROLOGY	4 ECTS
<p>The aim of the course is to learn about mostly woody taxa that are not in the basic requirement and to become experienced in the practical application of these species.          During the semester the classes provide knowledge of more than 250 species, subspecies and cultivars.          In the second part of the course, students tour two or three botanical gardens in Budapest and Vácrátót.          By learning different crown forms, leaf formations, bark textures of growing habits of plants, students' attention will be more sensible for the uniqueness of various species which can be used well even in different climatic conditions. The main goal is to learn how to use plants in different</p>
